Also known as the Clark–Calamba Railway, it aims to connect New Clark City to Calamba, Laguna, with 36 stations. Malolos is also beside the New Manila International Airport (NMIA) currently being constructed by San Miguel Corporation. Operations are scheduled to start in 2028 with an ability to handle 35 to 100 million passengers.*
